Our Organisation

Immervox provides IT and telecoms managed services across the UK. While our operations do not fall within high-risk sectors for modern slavery, we recognise our responsibility to maintain robust practices to prevent exploitation within our supply chains and partnerships.

Our Commitments

- We only engage suppliers and partners who can demonstrate compliance with the Modern Slavery Act 2015 or equivalent standards.
- We require suppliers to confirm that they have policies and controls in place to prevent modern slavery and human trafficking.
- We include contractual clauses where relevant to ensure compliance with ethical labour standards.
- We provide clear escalation routes should any concerns about unethical practices be identified in our supply chain.

Due Diligence and Risk Management

- Supplier assessments are carried out as part of our procurement process to ensure ethical practices are followed.
- Where suppliers operate in higher-risk industries or geographies, additional due diligence is undertaken.
- We monitor compliance and expect immediate corrective action from suppliers if issues are identified.

Training and Awareness

- Our managers are trained to recognise and escalate potential risks of modern slavery.
- Awareness is raised internally so that employees understand our responsibilities and can report concerns confidentially.

Continuous Improvement

Immervox reviews its policies annually to ensure ongoing compliance with legislation and evolving best practice. We are committed to continually strengthening our approach to ethical business and supply chain management.
